Abstract: The talk will discuss the importance of organizational learning and how this would be affected by the different approaches in corporate curriculum design. A micro case of a curriculum reform in industrial and system engineering programme at The Hong Kong Polytechnic University is described. Some experiences of launching KM projects in Hong Kong will also be addressed.

Biography: Prof. W.B. Lee, is the Cheng Yick-chi Chair Professor of Manufacturing Engineering and Head of the Department of Industrial and Systems Engineering and the Director of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Microsoft Enterprise Systems Center, Ultra-precision Machining Center and Advanced Technology Manufacturing Research Center.

He is the President of the Hong Kong Advancement of the Association of Science and Technology, Vice-Chairman of the Asian Pacific Academy of Productivity Innovation and Past Chairman of the Institution of Electrical Engineers Hong Kong. Professor Lee is the Fellow of the World Academy of Productivity Sciences.

Professor Lee is the regional editor of the Journal of Materials Processing Technology, member of the Editorial Board of the Chinese Journal of Mechanical, member of the Editorial Board of the Industrial Engineering Research, member of Editorial Board of the Proceedings the Institution of Mechanical Engineers UK, Part B : Journal of Engineering Manufacture. He had been Chairman of several International Conferences include IMCC, AEPA, and APCMP..

Professor Lee's research interests include manufacturing technology, dispersed network manufacturing system, manufacturing strategy, and knowledge management. He has published two research monographs, co-edited two books, and has more than 200 papers published in referred journals and conferences.
